Sun

Visible during the day. The best moment for observing is at 1:30 PM in the S at an altitude of 55°.

Moon

After sunset in the evening visible in the SSE in the constellation Archer. It is very bright ($mv = -11,8$) and a prominent object in the night and twilight sky. Best observing time is at 11:30 PM in the S at an altitude of 25°.

Mercury

Not visible at night. Will be observable from the middle of November in the morning.

Venus

Visible shortly after sunset (dusk) low in the W in the constellation Virgin and sets before midnight. It is very bright ($mv = -4,0$) and a prominent object in the night and twilight sky. Best observing time is at 9:10 PM in the W at an altitude of 6°.

Mars

Is visible in the morning before the start of dawn in the ENE in the constellation Twins. It is bright ($mv = 1,6$) and visible to the unaided eye. Best observing time is at 5:20 AM in the ENE at an altitude of 16°.

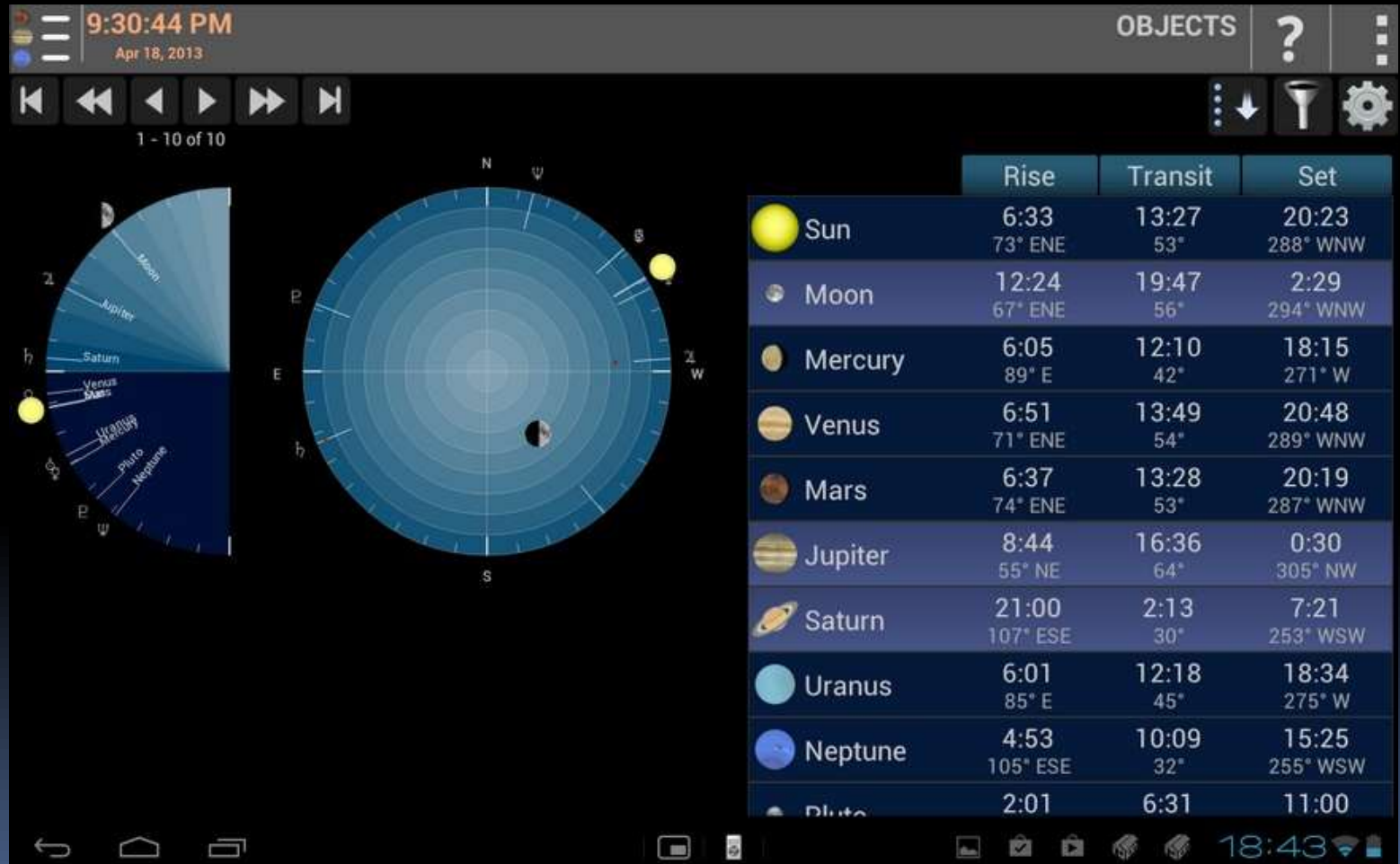
Jupiter

Rises after midnight and is visible in the morning long before sunrise in the E in the constellation Twins. It is pretty bright ($mv = -2,0$) and easily visible to the unaided eye. Best visibility at 5:50 AM in the E at an altitude of 30°.
